

Cougar Mountain Regional Wildlife Park

Harvey Manning Trailhead / Peak (Formerly Anti-Aircraft Peak)

From North Bend (West I-90)

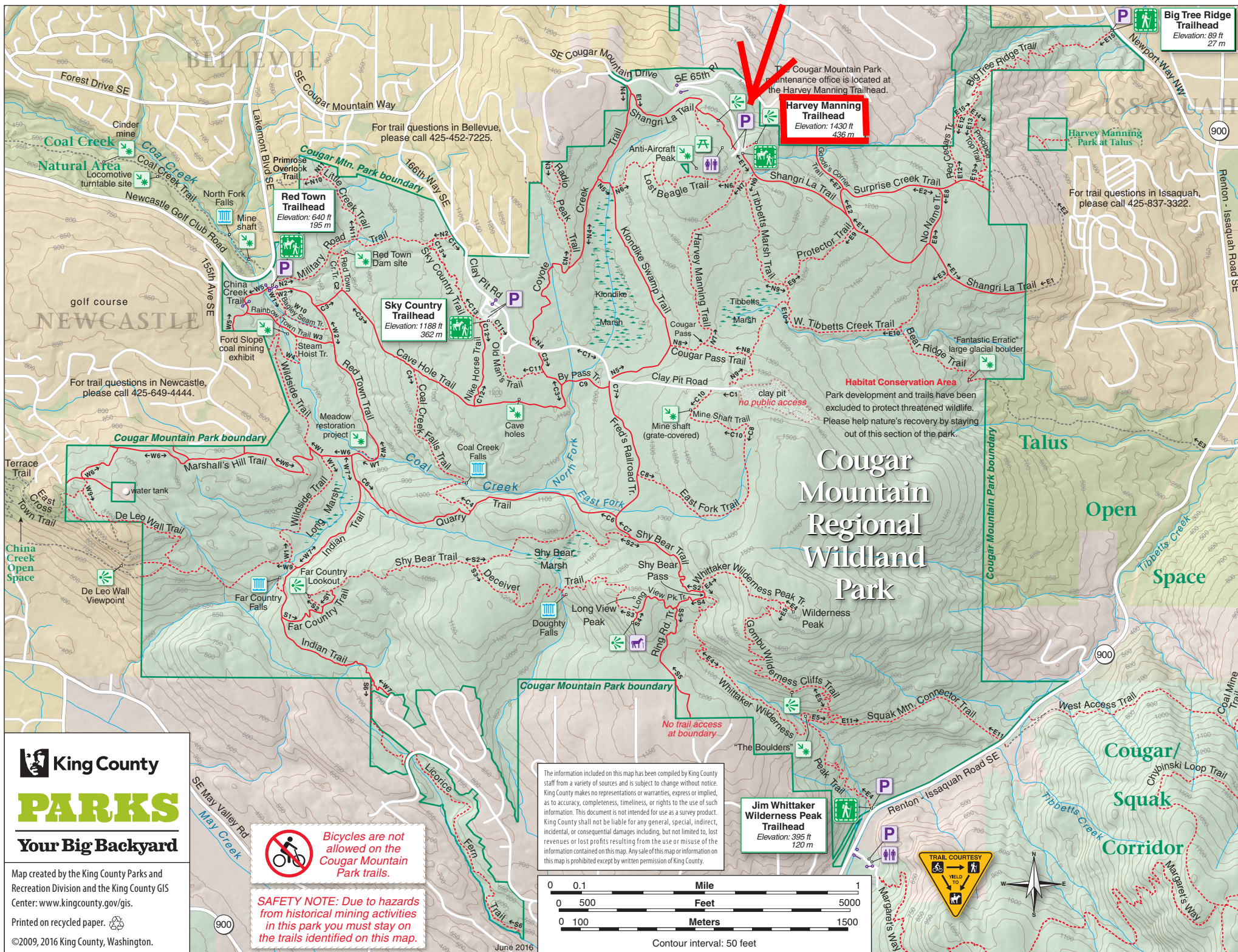
- Take Exit 13
- Turn left onto Lakemont Blvd. SE
 - Follow Lakemont Blvd. SE for 2.5 miles
- Turn left onto SE Cougar Mountain Way
 - Follow the double yellow line
 - Road will swing left to become 168th SE
 - Road will swing right to become SE 60th St
- Turn right, uphill onto SE Cougar Mountain Dr
 - Road will change to gravel and end at Harvey Manning Peak Trailhead
 - Wilderness Awareness School programs sign in at the field up the service road from the parking lot.

From Seattle (East I-90)

- Take Exit 13
- Turn right onto Lakemont Blvd. SE
 - Follow Lakemont Blvd. SE for 2.5 miles
